Resource Area Information

Access to current training resources, settlement information and job search support. Free use of computers, fax, telephone and other resources for job search activities.

Settlement Services

One-on-one support for immigrants and their families. Find information on everyday needs; banking, housing, childcare, supports for seniors, health care, cultural, educational and recreational services and referrals assistance with all government services.

Language Training

English language instruction to learn English language skills for daily communication, employment preparation and practical information about life in Canada. Learners must be assessed by the Language Assessment prior to registration.

For LINC (Language Instructions for Newcomers) free child-care services available: Ages 19 months to 5 years old (level 2 to 5 only) and transportation allowance to eligible participants.

For ESL (English as Second Language) full time and part-time Evening and Saturday Classes available

Enhanced Language Training (ELT) for professionals in Office Administration and Customer Service

Job specific language training in office administration and customer service. Program includes language instruction, pre-employment preparation, computer training and co-op placement.

Language Assessment

Language assessment based on the Canadian Language Benchmark for eligible individuals enrolling in language training classes.

Job Search Workshops (JSW)

Learn about job search strategies, hiring practices in your field, the Canadian business perspective, and how to build your professional network in Canada. Receive professional guidance with resume, cover letter and interview preparation. Your personalized action plan will include referrals and information to support your next steps in your job search.

Accreditation and Qualifications Information Services

Planning service for Internationally Trained Professionals and Trades people on how to obtain professional recognition in Canada, guiding client through licensing and evaluation process in their own fields, assisting them in exploring alternative careers, ways of gaining Canadian work experience and using international qualifications and skills towards further training and education.

Portfolio Workshop

Group workshop for people who are interested in developing their portfolio powerful tools to help gain the competitive edge in the job market.

Employment Settlement Specialist

Available to all unemployed or underemployed residents of York Region able to work in Canada. One-on-one support including Return to Work Action Plans, job search coaching, resume critique and career decision making.

Self-Employment Pathways

Program to help immigrants explore the idea of starting a business in Canada, for permanent residents, convention refugees, and live-in-caregivers. LINC Level 5 minimum is required. Group sessions, and individual business coaching to successfully develop a business concept.

Income Tax Clinic

Integration Network Program and WCRH now offer a Year-round Income Tax Clinic. Clients must have been in Canada 5 years or less and possess Permanent Residence or Canadian Citizenship Status. Clients with business or rental income do not qualify.

Networking Group

is for internationally trained professionals to meet, share experiences and receive coaching from professional lead volunteers. The group focuses on sharing information and resources, and networking with professionals who are internationally educated in Medical Science, Health Science, Pharmaceutical Sciences and Healthcare. It also includes exchange of info about employers, job postings and a Question/ Answer component

International Medical Graduates Study Group
