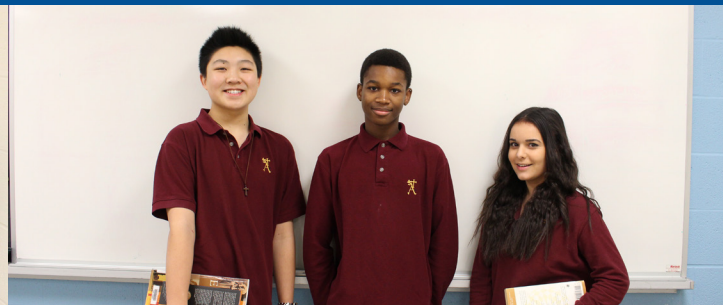

Elementary Registration

Who is eligible?

- Newcomer with Canadian immigration status
- Roman Catholic student or parent
- Eastern Orthodox Christian student
- Resides in York Region
- Student in Kindergarten to Grade 8

What is required for the appointment?

- Original immigration documents of student and parent such as passport, permanent resident document, work permit, refugee claimant papers
- Roman Catholic baptismal certificate of the student or parent
- Orthodox baptismal certificate of the student
- 2 proofs of address (rental or purchase agreement, utility bill, bank statement)

What is the next step?

- Take the registration package to the local elementary school for final approval

Where is the school?

- Students will be placed in schools according to school boundaries within their place of residence

Secondary Assessment

Who is eligible?

- Newcomer with Canadian immigration status
- Resides in York Region
- Student in Grade 9 to 12

What is required for the appointment?

- Original immigration documents of student and parent such as passport, permanent resident document, work permit, refugee claimant papers
- Official report cards/transcripts for the last 2 years
- 2 proofs of address (rental or purchase agreement, utility bill, bank statement)
- One parent/guardian must accompany the student to the appointment

How long is the assessment?

- Your appointment may take up to 4 hours

What is the next step?

- Take the package to the appropriate school

Where is the school?

- Students will be placed in appropriate secondary school after the assessment

Is Uniform mandated?

- Yes
